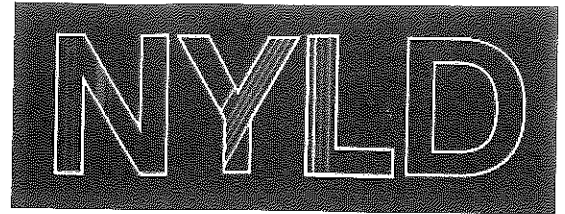


Dear Parent/ Caregiver
