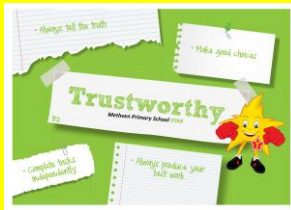


Welcome back to Term 2, 2018! We look forward to another exciting term of learning!
