

Mt Hutt Ski Passes

Only children aged 10 and under (as at 1st June 2019) will receive FREE lift passes at Mt Hutt Ski Area during the 2019 season.

So, if your child intends on taking part in the Friday Snow Sports option this year, we suggest you purchase a Local School Season Pass at the discounted cost of \$104.

If you wish to take up this opportunity, please return the attached form to the school office by this Wednesday 8th May. Apologies for the short notice!

More details regarding the 2019 Friday Snow Sports programme will be sent home in the next couple of weeks.

The following Terms & Conditions apply to your NZSki Pass or Mt Hutt pass as indicated within the text.

The operating season of the NZSki Limited (NZSki) areas is subject to snow, weather and market conditions and the season may be longer or shorter than publicised. NZSki makes no warrant as to the length of season, number of lifts operating at any time or to the operation or otherwise of an area on any particular day.

Reference to Season Pass, pass or mypass refers to the plastic RFID card and the products that are loaded against the individual that the RFID card identifies with in the NZSki database.

Purchase of a pass implies acceptance of the following Terms & Conditions:

PART A – APPLIES TO ALL PASS HOLDERS, 2019

1. Season Passes are non-refundable under any circumstances unless the Injury/Medical cover option has been purchased.
2. Injury/Medical cover provides for full or partial refund of the Season Pass where;

an injury or medical condition precludes or significantly limits ability to use the pass.

All applications for refund must be made by completing the [Injury/Medical Cover Refund Form](#) and supported with a doctor's certificate or other evidence acceptable to NZSki. NZSki reserves the right to obtain independent medical advice to validate any claim.

The value of refunds will be calculated based on the use of the pass according to the table below and in conjunction with the following expiry dates. There will be no refunds after 6 weeks from the pass holders first day of pass use.

There will be no refunds after 31 August 2019.

Refunds extend to the value of the pass type purchased only and do not cover any ancillary or other associated costs. The Injury/Medical cover add-on is regarded as an ancillary cost.

Refunds will be made to the credit card used to purchase the pass and the pass will be cancelled.

3. Applications for issued Season Passes are not transferable. The pass may only be used by the person whose name it bears and photograph it matches in NZSki's records. Transferring or re-selling your Season Pass is an offence and will result in penalties including loss of access to ski area facilities and possible prosecution.
4. If you lose your pass or it is stolen please report it immediately on 0800 NZSKIPASS (0800 697 547) so we can suspend/cancel it. An administration fee will apply to replace your pass.
5. NZSki reserves the right to decline to reissue the pass or to issue you with passes in the future if a third party is found using your pass without its loss recorded in our system.
6. Your pass cannot be used for commercial purposes without the prior approval of NZSki Ltd.
7. Photo identification will be required on collection of your pass/card or when updating your photograph.
8. All pass holders must abide by the ski area user responsibility code. Misconduct will result in cancellation or suspension of the pass with no refund. Misconduct includes, but is not limited to, reckless or dangerous skiing or riding, excessive speed within a slow or learning zone, disregard for closed areas, unsociable behaviour, skiing or riding under the influence of alcohol or drugs, supply of incorrect information or breach of the conditions as per the Snow Responsibility Code available at www.nzski.com.
9. All pass holders must abide by all signs and instructions when driving on ski area access roads. Failure to abide by signs and instructions or reckless and dangerous driving will result in cancellation or suspension of the pass with no refund.
10. You must carry your pass with you at all times when skiing or riding.
11. Use of any season pass is subject to the Terms & Conditions of the specific ski area at which you are using the pass.

PART B – SPECIFIC TO SEASON PASS TYPES, 2019

1. The 3 Peak Pass provides the holder with unlimited skiing and riding at Coronet Peak, Mt Hutt and The Remarkables for the 2019 season during standard operating hours of 9am – 4pm, plus Night Skiing at Coronet Peak on Wednesday, Friday and Saturday nights from 4pm – 9pm when available.
2. The Mt Hutt Pass provides holders with unlimited skiing and riding at Mt Hutt only for the 2019 season during standard operating hours of 9am – 4pm. In addition, holders are entitled to a \$20 discount for adults and \$15 discount for youths and seniors on the standard day pass rates at Coronet Peak and The Remarkables.
3. The Coronet Peak First Tracks add-on provides access to the Coronet Express lift from 8am – 9am from late June / early July through to late in the 2019 season. The operation of First Tracks is subject to the availability and operation of the lifts and to snow & weather conditions. Access to trails will be subject to operational requirements, weather and snow conditions and any scheduled race/events. Coronet Peak does not guarantee the operation of First Tracks on any particular day.
4. The Mt Hutt First Tracks add-on provides access to the Summit Six Express lift & Exhibition Quad Chair from 8am-9am from late June/early July through to late in the 2019 season, Saturday and Sundays only. The operation of First Tracks is subject to the availability and operations of the lift and to snow and weather conditions. Access to trail will be subject to operational requirements, weather and snow conditions and any scheduled race/events. Mt Hutt does not guarantee the operation of First tracks every weekend.
5. Pass holder conditions as in Part A above also apply.

Age definitions (as at 1 June 2019)

Adult	18 to 64 years (inclusive)
Student	18+ years enrolled full time with a New Zealand or Australian tertiary institution or secondary school. To be considered full time you must attend such institution a minimum of 32 weeks in the 2019 calendar year. Student ID <u>and</u> proof of full-time status in the form of a letter from the institution to be presented at the time of pass collection. ID card must be in English and include a valid expiry date. ISIC cards not accepted.
Youth	7 – 17 years
Senior	65 – 74 years (proof of age may be required)
Super Senior	75+ years

Child and Super Senior applications

For convenience, we can produce a season pass for children aged five years and under at Coronet Peak and The Remarkables, and children aged 10 years and under at Mt Hutt, or Super Seniors aged 75+ years. Both groups would normally receive free day lift passes however this pass enables the holder to proceed directly to the lifts and avoid a visit to Guest Services each time you ski. There is a \$5 application and card issue fee.

LOCAL SCHOOLS SEASON PASS 2019 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Winter is fast approaching which means it's time to organise your child's season pass at the local rate. For the third year running, the Local School Pass gives your child unlimited skiing to all three of our mountains; Mt Hutt, Coronet Peak and The Remarkables. And we've reduced the price this year too! If you have any questions, we've got some handy FAQ below for you, if that doesn't cover it, please don't hesitate to get in touch with us. Otherwise, we look forward to seeing you on the slopes!

BY WHEN DO I HAVE TO SEND MY APPLICATION IN?

The deadline for getting your application back to your child's school is Monday the 29th of April, the first day back after the school holidays.

WHERE DO I SEND THE APPLICATION FORM?

All forms must be sent back, with payment method, to your local school. Any applications sent to our office directly will not be processed.

WHAT ABOUT AGES 10 AND UNDER?

You can purchase your season pass for ages 10 & under via our website www.mthutt.co.nz. This season pass is available for a \$5 admin fee at any point before or during the 2019 winter season, there is no deadline for purchase. Please be aware that any submitted applications for 10 and under passes will not be processed.

WHICH PASS IS RIGHT FOR MY CHILD?

Our local school pass is a 3 Peak NZSki pass that gives unlimited access to Mt Hutt, Coronet Peak and The Remarkables for the 2019 winter season. If you're planning a family trip to Queenstown this winter, and your child is aged 6-10 years old, your cheapest option is the \$104 year 7 or 8 pass. Free day passes and \$5 season passes are only available to children aged 5 and under in Queenstown.

WHAT IF MY CHILD ALREADY HAS A MYPASS CARD?

If your child already has a mypass card from last year, ensure to write down the number on the front of the card on your application form. This means we can load their season pass straight to that card so it's ready to go for the first day of the season, which this year is scheduled for Friday the 7th of June.

WHAT ABOUT PHOTOS?

Profile pictures can be taken on your child's first day on the mountain. Or, to avoid the queues, you can visit us at the Mt Hutt Snow Desk from Tuesday the 21st of May at the Methven Heritage Centre. If your child had their picture taken last year and still has their pass, they're ready to head straight to the lifts!

WHERE DO I COLLECT MY CHILD'S PASS?

If your child needs to be issued a new season pass, you can collect this from Guest Services on the mountain, or from our Snow Desk at The Methven Heritage Centre.

MY CHILD NOW HAS AN 3 PEAK PASS, CAN I UPGRADE MINE?

Yes! You can upgrade to the 3 Peak pass at the same rate you purchased your Mt Hutt pass. For example, if you purchased at early bird rate, you can upgrade to 3 Peak Pass at the early bird price. The 3 Peak Pass and Mt Hutt pass are on sale at early bird prices until Thursday the 5th of April.

WHAT IF MY CHILD IS 11 AND NOT IN YEAR 7?

No problem! You can opt for the \$100 season pass, which is your cheapest option for skiing unlimitedly on all three mountains for the duration of the 2018 winter season.
